

## The very best walks on Corsica

7 days / 6 nights

A seven day itinerary, which takes in the stunning Corsican coastline, as well as the dramatically mountainous interior. The scenery that you will experience on your walks is different every day and is seriously beautiful. After each day of walking, you will return to sumptuous accommodation, selected for you as some of the best places to stay on Corsica. What is there not to enjoy?

### YOUR PROGRAM

#### Day 1 - The bay of Saint Florent

You will be met at Bastia airport and then transferred privately to your hotel that sits directly within the bay of Saint Florent on the west coast of Corsica. Enjoy the beach, the pool, visit the chic port of Saint Florent and perhaps dine in the hotel restaurant (one Michelin star).

Night in this wonderful "hotel de charme"

#### Day 2 - Lodu beach and the Mortella tower

After a delicious breakfast, you will take a thirty minute boat ride from Saint Florent towards the beautiful beaches of Saleccia and Lodu, the most beautiful beaches on Corsica. From here, you will have a superb walk along the coastline, passing hidden creeks and taking you through the wild "maquis" (Corsican scrub packed with herbs, wild asparagus and wild flowers depending upon the season). You will reach the ruins of the majestic Genoese Mortella tower before continuing along the coast in the direction of Saint Florent and your hotel.

Night in the same "hotel de charme"

Approximately 3 hours 30 minutes of walking

Approximately 12km

Elevation : +180 m ; -180 m



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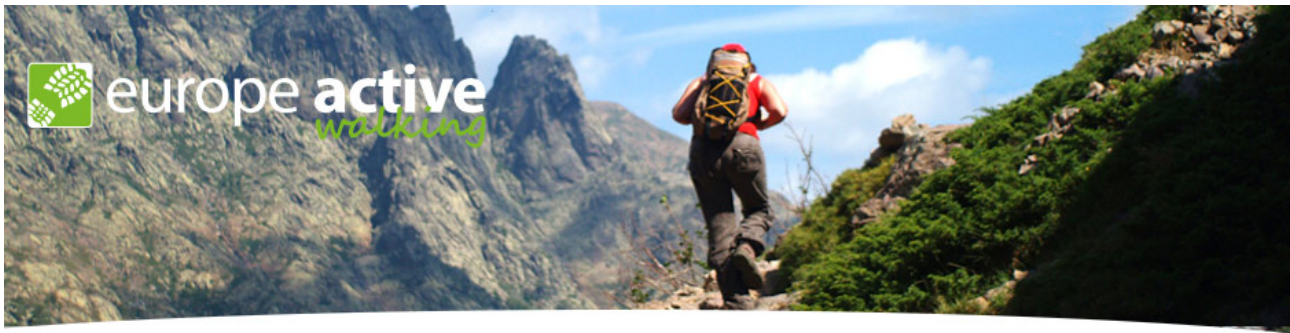
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### **Day 3 - Towards the Balagne**

Enjoy the cafe culture of Saint Florent before a private transfer takes you through the stunning wilderness known as the "Agriates" towards the heart of the Balagne region. You will arrive at the seaside town of Calvi, where you can wander around the old town and citadel or, should you so wish, you can take a walk to the Notre Dame de la Serra Chapel, with its breathtaking view over the bay. Alternatively, why not take a boat to the Scandola nature reserve or undertake one of the many other activities that are proposed in the area.

Night in a five star hotel.

### **Day 4 - Calvi - To the Austrian cross or the Revellata lighthouse.**

You have the choice of two superb walks. The first takes you to the highest point above Calvi, an exhilarating walk with incredible panoramic views. The second takes you along the coast to the Revellata lighthouse on a wild peninsular to the south of the town, where you can profit from the turquoise waters and stunning coastal landscapes.

The Austrian cross:

Approximately: 12km and 5 hours of walking.

Elevation: +700m, -700m.

The Revellata lighthouse:

Approximately 14km and 3 hours 30 minutes of walking.

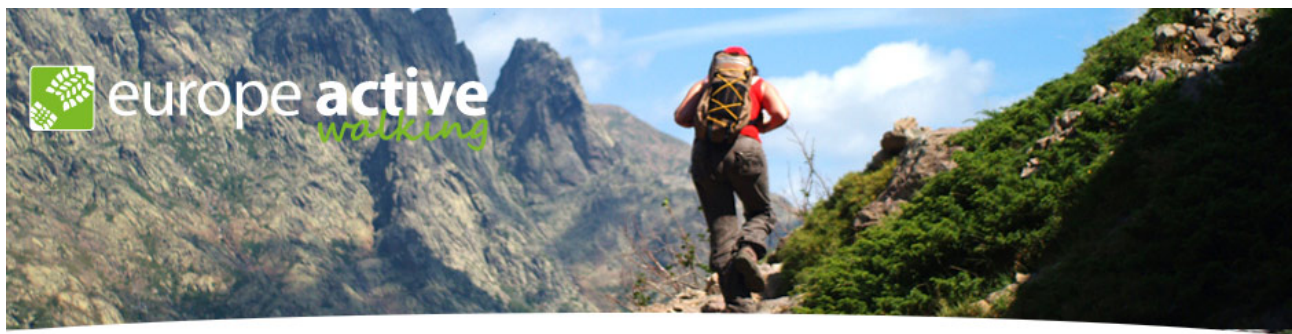
Elevation: +186m, -175m.

Night in a five star hotel.

### **Day 5 - The Corsican train; original and unforgettable.**

Today you will discover another side of Corsica; the interior. After a transfer to Calvi train station, you will board the train that will take you through quite magnificent landscapes. From village to village, from the coast to the empty and mountainous heart of the island, you will reach Corte, the ancient capital of Corsica. A taxi will meet you at the train station and transfer you to your hotel in a beautiful setting next to the river.

Night in a "hotel de charme" in Corte.



### **Day 6 - The Tavignano Gorge**

After another delicious breakfast, you will make your way into Corte, through the citadel and past the museum charting the history of Corsica. On the other side of the town, you will come to the magnificent Tavignano gorge. Walking up the gorge your eyes will be open to completely new and exciting landscapes, that will leave you in awe of this fiercely proud island. Eventually you will come to the bridge over the river where you can bathe in the rock pools with crystal clear waters. Return after a refreshing swim back down to Corte.

Approximately 11km and 4h00 of walking.

Elevation: +545m, -545m

Night in the same "hotel de charme" in Corte.

### **Day 7 - Towards Bastia**

After breakfast, a private transfer will be organised for you back to Bastia airport.

## **Additional information**

### **TARIFFS**

Price from 2620 euros per person.

### **OPTIONS**

Single room supplement : 890 euros per person.

Summer supplement (June, July, August) : 499 euros per person.

### **INCLUDED**

6 nights in double or twin rooms, 6 breakfasts, route notes and maps, transfers from and to the airport and between hotels, contactable daily assistance (7 days a week).

### **NOT INCLUDED**



The transport to and from the rendez-vous point, transfers not mentioned in the programme, insurance, drinks, meals, visit to tourist sites and personal expenses.

**LEVEL OF DIFFICULTY**

Necessary to be in good shape. Two to six hours of walking per day.

Your luggage is transported to your accommodation. You only need to walk with your personal daily items (camera, water etc).
